## **Rocky Incline Trail Short Loop**



### **Highlights**

- This is a good short workout route
- Connects to many other trails in the area, and to Wood Ranch in Simi Valley
- Rocky Incline Trail is a really fun downhill for experienced mountain bikers
- One of the segments of the 2022 Conejo Open Space Challenge (https://cosf.org/challenge)

#### **Description**

This short loop is a good workout because both Alapay and Rocky Incline Trails are pretty steep! Experienced mountain bikers love to speed down Rocky Incline so hikers should go up it so they can see oncoming traffic. Make sure to keep dogs on their leashes!

#### **Key Statistics**

**Popularity:** Very high likelihood of encountering other visitors. Mountain bikers take note!

Parking: Free at the trailhead at the east end of Lang Ranch Parkway.

Distance: 3.0 miles.

Cumulative Climbing and Descent: About 700'

**Tread Surface:** Mostly firm fire road; Rocky Incline Trail is a wide singletrack trail with loose, rutted and rocky sections.

**Hazards:** No shade; riders speeding down Rocky Incline Trail, some loose rocky sections.


**Facilities:** Benches (orange stars on the map, but off the route)

**Connections:** To many other trails in the Lang Ranch and Wood Ranch (Simi Valley) open spaces. Also connects to China Flat up Albertson Motorway.


**Driving Directions:** From the 23 Freeway, take Exit 15 at Avenida De Los Arboles and head east. Drive 1.4 miles to Westlake Blvd and turn right. Take the next left, after 0.2 miles, onto Lang Ranch Parkway and drive 0.8 miles to the Albertson Fireroad trailhead at the end. In the early and late hours, please keep the noise down so as not to disturb the neighbors.
